Across Louisiana, schools, recreation centers, parks, churches, and libraries are serving free, nutritious **summer meals to kids age 18 and younger** through the **USDA's Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)**. SFSP is a federally-funded, state-administered program that reimburses providers who serve free, nutritious meals and snacks to children and teens in low-income areas when school is not in session.

Louisiana has nearly 900 summer meal sites serving more than 3.5 million meals each summer to children in communities throughout the state.
