

Behind on child support and need your license reinstated?

Here's your chance to get

On the Road Again

For a limited time beginning August 1, the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services is offering an opportunity for payors of child support (Non-Custodial Parents) whose driver's licenses have been administratively suspended to get your license reinstated for a reduced amount.

How it works

For each case, pay

- Two months of court-ordered child support, and
- \$100 toward arrears or past-due support, and
- Administrative fee, if court ordered

This payment does **not** include any reinstatement fees or fines that may be required by the Louisiana Office of Motor Vehicles.

Get started

Speak with your caseworker to determine the exact amount needed to qualify.
