 - The percentage of Foster Children currently receiving SSI/SSDI collected by DCFS-CW is 5.49%.

- 5. Will our company have a role in the Social Security Onsite Review process?
 - The company will have a role in the Social Security Onsite Review process. Per Section 2.3 of RFP, 'the contractor shall provide all services connected with pursuing SSI/SSDI eligibility and related communication with the Social Security Administration on behalf of children placed in Louisiana's foster care system including those classified as transition cases'.
- 6. Will DCFS supply us with medical and school records for hearings?
 - DCFS-CW will provide medical and school records available in the foster child's case record for hearings.
 However, Section 2.2, B, 2 of the RFP states that 'the Contractor shall collect, review and assemble all supplemental and supporting documentation for the application'.
- 7. What is the average number of children in foster care on a daily basis?
 - The number of children in foster care changes daily. However, the average number of children in foster care daily for August 2018 is 4459.
- 8. How many children currently in the care of the Department are receiving SSI, SSDI, or both benefits?
 - DCFS-CW received SSI and/or SSDI benefits for 255 foster children in August 2018.
- 9. How many initial Title XVI and Title II applications have been filed by the Department for the past three years? Of the applications submitted, how many have been approved for benefits?
 - The number of Title XVI and Title II applications filed by DCFS-CW is unknown. Applications are completed manually. Application counts are not tracked.

- 10. How many Continuing Disability Reviews (CDR's) have been completed by the Department and submitted to SSA over the past three years?
 - The number of Continuing Disability Reviews completed by DCFS-CW and submitted to SSA is unknown. The CDRs are completed manually. CDR counts are not tracked.
- 11. How many Change of Payees and Change of Placement applications have been submitted over the past three years?
 - The number of Change of Payees and Change of Placement applications completed by DCFS-CW is unknown. Payee and Placement changes are processed manually. Payee and Placement change counts are not tracked.
- 12. How many applications were filed, with SSA, last year by the State of Louisiana?
 - The number of applications completed by Louisiana DCFS is unknown. Applications are completed manually. Application counts are not tracked.
- 13. What was the State's approval rating?
 - Louisiana's approval rating is unknown.
- 14. What is the average length of time for approval?
 - Average approval times are unknown. Applications are completed manually. There are no mechanisms for tracking length of time applications are processed and approved.
- 15. Does the State have a connected system for reporting information placement categories along with gaining access to SSA's information system known as SDX/BENDEX? If so, what's the name of the current system used?
 - DCFS-CW does not have an automated system to report placement information to SSA. The agency does have the State Income Eligibility Verification System (SIEVS) to obtain BENDEX information regarding wages and SSI and SSA benefits.
- 16. Can the State provide the current number of children in the Youth Transition Program that are getting ready to age out of foster care?
 - 84 foster children are expected to age out of foster care between July 1, 2018 December 31, 2018.

171 foster children are expected to age out of foster care between July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019.
