Support foster caregivers in your organization

- Organize meal trains or provide gift cards to local restaurants when children are initially placed in the home
- Provide Christmas and birthday gifts for children and teens in the family's care
- Encourage foster families within your organization to connect by organizing support group meetings throughout the year
- Provide a flexible work schedule to allow foster caregivers to attend court hearings, DCFS meetings, and appointments related to the care of their child
- Offer flexible working arrangements, such as working from home
- Provide paid leave for foster caregivers when children are initially placed in the home.
