



ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Lost your driver's license due to unpaid child support? The Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services is offering noncustodial parents an opportunity to get their licenses reinstated for a reduced amount and get "On the Road Again."

This limited-time promotion ends September 30, 2025.

How it works:

For most child support cases, pay:

- Two months of court-ordered child support
- and \$100 toward arrears or past-due support
- and Administrative fees, if court-ordered

This amount does not include any reinstatement fees from the Louisiana Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV).
